Stand Up Forklift Attachments - The ICE powered forklifts are accordingly labeled to the fuel kind utilized. Type "G" forklifts are gasoline fueled. These meet fire hazard least standards and is the most widespread designation for gas powered lift trucks. Lift trucks labeled "G" are not used in hazardous places for obvious reasons. Type "GS" forklifts are gasoline fueled and satisfy all of the requirements of a Type "G" lift truck and have various devices installed to the exhaust and electrical and fuel system so as to allow them to be utilized in certain hazardous sites. Type "GS" trucks are used in similar applications to Type "EE" electric forklifts.

The "LP" class of lift trucks are LPG powered and do not satisfy minimum standards for fire hazards and must not be utilized in hazardous locations. This is however the most frequent designation for lift trucks fueled by LPG. Type "LPS" trucks are LPG fueled and meet all requirements of a Type "G" truck. They have other pieces of equipment set up to the electrical system, fuel system, and exhaust system so as to allow them to be utilized in some unsafe applications. Type "LPS" lift trucks are used in similar applications to Type "GS" and Type "EE" electric trucks.

As dual fuel units, the "G/LP" forklifts could be operated on either gasoline or LPG. These lift trucks are not to be utilized in hazardous sites, yet meet minimum requirements for fire hazards. Type "GS/LPS" forklifts are dual fuel models because they can be operated on LPG or gasoline without whichever alteration to the fuel system. These forklifts satisfy all the requirements of a Type "GS" or Type "LPS" truck and consist of other machines installed to their fuel system, exhaust system and electrical system, to be able to allow them to be used in certain unsafe applications. Type "GS/LPS" forklifts are used in similar applications to Type "GS", Type "LPS" and Type "EE" electric forklifts.

Type "D" lift trucks represent diesel fueled and meet the minimum requirements for fire hazards. These lift trucks labeled "D" are not utilized in dangerous sites. Type "DS" lift trucks are fueled by diesel and meet all the requirements of a Type "D" truck and comprise various equipment installed to the electrical system, fuel system, and exhaust system so as to allow them to be utilized in some unsafe locations. Type "DS" forklifts are utilized in similar applications to Type "GS", Type "LPS" and Type "EE" electric trucks. Type "DY" forklifts are fueled by diesel and satisfy all the requirements of Type "DS" trucks and also do not comprise whichever electrical equipment installed. These make use of air starters and have provisions for controlling the temperature of truck parts. These type forklifts are utilized in similar application to the Type "EE" electric forklifts.
