Doosan Forklift Parts - Doosan Infracore Company Ltd. is a transnational organization consisting of Diesel Engines, Defense Industry goods, Industrial Vehicles, Construction Technologies and Machine Instruments and Mechanization Systems.

In the United States, Doosan Infracore America Corporation is headquartered in Suwanee, Georgia. It is home to a 170,000 square foot manufacturing facility, which is the home of the Compact Equipment and Construction division. West Caldwell, New Jersey is home to the Machine Tool division and Cleveland, Ohio is home to the Lift truck division. The U.S. headquarters in Georgia facilitates a first rate parts operation capable of supplying an excess of 25,000 line items to support Lift Truck, Compact Equipment, Machine Tool and Construction client requirements.

With a association consisting of over 90 autonomous sellers, the forklift group supplies quality materials handling equipment to the comprehensive North American market. Doosan Infracore America Lift Truck sellers successfully operate in over 220 service and sales locations all through Canada and the U.S. The lift truck product line remarkably features 63 distinctive machines consisting of 82 various battery and engine configurations of Electric-powered and Internal Combustion lift trucks. Capacities of these numerous truck versions range from 3,000 to 33,000 lbs. All vehicles are manufactured in an ISO 9001 certified facility.

Doosan Infracore America is the fastest expanding lift truck company in the North American market, thanks to their consistency in maintaining a high degree of consumer service quality and optimum product functioning to all Doosan Infracore Lift Truck users. The U.S. lift Truck division stationed in Cleveland has a professional team experienced in Product Sales, Purchasing, Advertising, Logistical and Technical Support.

At first the home-based forklift marketplace in Korea was an open import enterprise. Korea Machinery Co. Ltd. started in 1960, to import fully assembled lift trucks as part of a home-based equipment expansion project. Sales of these products were originally targeted to state-run corporations, large scale businesses, and the armed forces. This eventually led to a unification with Daewoo Heavy Industries Ltd. In 1976, the Forklift Division begun business operations throughout Korea to service and sell this heavy equipment. By 1978, a lift truck production plant was successfully completed. Continuous technical instruction grew to become the new focus for improving quality and product development.

Domestic lift truck trade for Daewoo started in 1967 and grew to an amazing 90% market share in Korea. By the 1980's, Daewoo's sophisticated technological advancements combined with sales success placed them in a situation of significant growth of their forklift operations.

Caterpillar Industrial Inc. of the U.S. in 1981, proposed a joint venture project to assist them in the highly competitive North American materials handling industry. This joint-venture proved highly successful for Daewoo and their lift truck sales expanded greatly. In 1984, the company completed development of a new facility to help in producing high end value-added products for export. In 1993, the company had a global sales network and started exporting versions they had established through in-house technology, as an sovereign brand. Certifications were then acquired from CE of Europe, UL of the United States and ISO 14001 and ISO 9001, securing growth opportunities into international marketplaces.
